## **New Testament Healing Truth**

- 1. Jesus healed all who had need of healing.
- 2. Jesus never turned anyone away who had need of healing.
- 3. Jesus never required a changed life before healing anybody.
  - a. After healing He would sometimes say, "Go and sin no more lest a worse thing come upon thee."
  - b. All sickness is the result of the fall, but not all sickness is the result of sin.
- 4. Jesus never told anybody to wait for the timing of the Father to be healed.
- 5. Jesus never counseled people out of their sickness.
- 6. Jesus commanded devils to leave.
- 7. Jesus commanded sickness to leave (rebuked the fever).
- 8. Jesus did not ask the Father to heal a person.
  - a. He knew He had been given the Holy Spirit to manifest the bread (Luke 11)
- 9. Jesus often laid His hands on people to heal them.
- 10. Jesus sometimes healed from a distance using only the spoken Word.
- 11. Jesus equated forgiveness of sin and healing of the body to be part of redemption.
  - a. Which is easier to say, Thy sins be forgiven or take up thy bed and walk.
  - b. The communion consists of two parts, the bread and the cup
  - c. The body broken at the whipping post for your healing.
  - d. The blood shed at the cross for forgiveness of sin.
  - e. Healing and forgiveness of sin are in the atonement.
- 12. Jesus said believers are to lay hands on the sick and they will recover.
- 13. Jesus did not tell us to pray for the sick.
- 14. Jesus told us to heal the sick.
- 15. Jesus has given disciples authority over all the power of the enemy. (Luke 10:19)
- 16. The law of the spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made us free from the law of sin and death.
  - a. You have life within you that kills any germ that attacks your body.
  - b. Jesus was never sick. You never need be sick.
  - c. Jesus commanded sickness to leave. You command sickness to leave (your body as well as anybody else's.
- 17. Just a little faith in God is enough to move any mountain.
  - a. Great faith believes in the absolute authority of the Word of God.
    - i. Speak the word only.
  - b. Great faith does not take no for an answer.
    - i. God in the flesh told the woman "No" and she still stood for her daughter.
- 18. No sickness can remain whenever communion is taken correctly in faith.

## **Regarding Disciples**

- 1. Jesus did not tell us to pray for the sick.
- 2. Jesus told us to heal the sick.
- 3. We have the Name of Jesus.
  - a. We have all the authority that is in that name.
  - b. Nothing has more power than the name of Jesus.
- 4. We have the life of Christ within us that kills any disease that attacks our body.
- 5. We have received power when we received the baptism in the Holy Spirit.
- 6. We have faith in God.
  - a. We speak to the mountain and it obeys us every time.
  - b. We command sickness to leave.
  - c. We command devils to come out and enter them no more.
  - d. We believe that when we speak, God moves to manifest what we say.
- 7. Life flows through our hands into the bodies of others by the agency of the Holy Spirit when we lay hands on them.
  - a. "I am come that might have life ... and life in abundance."
  - b. We have abundance to share with others.
  - c. Our cup runneth over.
  - d. Out of our bellies flow rivers of LIVING WATER.
    - i. The well of salvation is for us.
    - ii. The river is for us and the world.
- 8. The disciples did not ask the Father to heal individual people.
  - a. The closest is "Stretch forth thine hand to heal by the name of thy Holy Child Jesus" at the very beginning of their ministry.
  - b. From that time forward they cast out devils and healed the sick by commandment just like Jesus did.
