

Dear Friend,

Many people are not aware that Jesus is called, "the last Adam."

1Co 15:45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.

Why would Jesus be called "the last Adam?" Because both the first Adam and Jesus were empowered to spawn a species of people. The first Adam spawned the human race. The last Adam also spawned a race ... a spiritual race ... the sons of God.

Joh 1:12-13 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: (13) Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

The first Adam failed when he was tempted. He disobeyed the Word of God. Many people do not know why the first thing Jesus did after He was baptized in the Holy Ghost was to be led of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. Why? It was imperative that the last Adam be victorious where the first Adam failed.

How did the first Adam fail? He disobeyed the Word of God. What caused the last Adam to be victorious? He would not disobey the Word of God. Notice how Jesus conquered. He simply said what God had said. "It is written, it is written, it is written." Jesus would quote the Word of God.

I have often wondered why the first man Adam remained silent. When Eve ate of the forbidden fruit and offered it to Adam, why did he not do what Jesus did? Why did he not simply say what God had said? Adam should have replied, "God has said we may eat of every tree of the garden except of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. I refuse to eat it." Adam remained silent, and then disobeyed God when he ate the forbidden fruit. Jesus did not remain silent. He spoke the Word of God and He obeyed the Word of God.

The Christian church in America has remained silent for far too long. Instead of proclaiming the truth from the rooftops like Jesus commanded us to, we have taken the back seat on so many issues that now evil prevails in the land. Just during my own life time of 73 years, the church has stood on the sidelines while prayer and Bible study was taken out of our schools; while abortion on demand became the law of the land, and while marriage was redefined to be acceptable between a man and a man, and between a woman and a woman. God forgive us for our silence.

This is the last letter you will receive from me before our November election. I believe this election is not about personalities or party affiliation. This election is about righteousness or darkness. Regardless of the personality of the persons running for office, the lines between light and dark could not be more clear.

In the Old Testament, the nation of Israel kept becoming more and more like the ungodly nations that surrounded them with every passing generation. It began with Solomon, who started off in a very godly way when he first became king but was influenced by all of his foreign-born wives and concubines.

Slowly over time, he was influence by them to honor their pagan gods. He kept moving further and further away from the one true God. Eventually Solomon actually built a high place to honor the pagan god Molech.

The pagan god Molech was an idol made of metal. This idol was hollow so that a roaring fire could be built inside of it. The intense heat would eventually make the metal idol glow red hot. The idol had its arms extended so that a baby could be laid in its hands. When the infant was laid on that glowing hot metal, the child would scream in agony as it died. Why would the people do such an abdominal thing? They wanted to be blessed by the god Molech. They wanted abundant rain for their crops. In today's vernacular, they wanted "their best life now."

The modern version of offering our babies to Molech is called "abortion on demand." Since that abominable law was passed, more than sixty million babies have been sacrificed on the altar of abortion. Why? The vast majority of those innocent babies (most estimates say over 95%) are murdered so the parent's life will not be encumbered with the duties and expense of raising another child. People are still wanting "their best life now." And if that means murdering their unborn child to have it, so be it.

God forgive us. Heaven is thundering to the church for all who will listen, "The days of silence are over!" One way to make your voice heard is to vote in the upcoming election. I say again, if you vote for any party or any candidate that is pro-abortion ... you will answer to God for it. Personally, I don't care much for the personalities of either of the candidates running for president. But it is abundantly clear which one is pro-life and which one promotes the continuation of abortion on demand. DO NOT REMAIN SILENT.
