Review

Mark 1:14-15 KJV Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, [15] And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

The time is fulfilled

When Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist, that was coronation day for Him to become the Last Adam. Then Jesus was victorious over Satan's temptations in the wilderness. He succeeded where the first Adam failed. Now Jesus is the last Adam, the king of the kingdom of God.

The kingdom of God is at hand

Anything that is at hand is within your reach. It is available to you now. It is yours and you can have it now. God has made the power of His kingdom available to you through Jesus, the king of the kingdom of God. That is the good news (the gospel) of the kingdom of God.

Repent ye, and believe the gospel

Jesus is saying you need to change your mind because you have not believed God will exercise His power on your behalf. Change your mind and believe the gospel of the kingdom. God is very willing to use His power on your behalf to help you. Change your mind and believe.

Believe

There is a big difference between having knowledge and believing. We all know that if, somehow, Jesus could walk through the wall of our home right now ... He would do the same thing He has always done. He would cast out devils, heal the sick, open the eyes of the blind, and so forth. God does not change. Jesus does not change.

Discipleship

Luke 6:40 AMPC A pupil is not superior to his teacher, but everyone [when he is] completely trained (readjusted, restored, set to rights, and perfected) will be like his teacher.

John 8:31-32 KJV Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; [32] And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

ANSWERED PRAYER: I saw these two verses side by side.

Mark 1:15 KJV And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

Mark 11:24 KJV Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Mark 1:15 - The time is now because I have been anointed as the king (the last Adam), and all authority has been given unto me. God has anointed me with the Holy Spirit to enforce that dominion. Up until now you have not believed that God will use His power on your behalf to give you abundant life. As the king of the kingdom, I am telling you to completely change your mind and believe that God will use His power on your behalf if you ask him.

Mark 11:24 - Because you believed what I said in Mark 1:15, I am teaching you now how to access the power of the kingdom. Because you believe what I said in Mark 1:15, when you ask God the Father for anything, believe He says yes. That's what I meant in Mark 1:15. Believe what I said. If you believe that He said yes, that means you know you have received it from Him, then you shall have it.

If you believe what Jesus said in Mark 1:15, then of course you will believe you receive when you pray because God always says yes when you pray in the name of Jesus.

2 Corinthians 1:20 NKJV For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.

John 16:23-24 KJV And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. [24] Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

The kingdom of God is at hand. = (His power on your behalf)

= Whatsoever you shall ask the Father in my name, He will give it you.

Authority When You Speak – I saw these two verses side by side

Luke 10:19 KJV Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Mark 11:23 KJV For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

The context of Luke 10:19 -

Luke 10:9,17 KJV And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you. [17] And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

The devils are subject to "us" ... through your name. (I give unto "you" authority)

When our thinking is the same as Jesus, that's when we "have faith in God" as Jesus declared in Mark 11:22. Said another way, believe what Jesus said in Mark 1:15 because everything else flows from that proclamation. Because of what Jesus said in Mark 1:15, we understand why Jesus said,

Mark 16:17 KJV And these signs shall follow them that believe; <u>In my name</u> shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

The authority to cast out devils is based on one thing alone ... "them that believe."
