

Recoding The Brain – Part 1

(Going From Laughing Unbelief To Strong In Faith)

The goal is revival, the kind where Jesus can do His work via the Holy Spirit through you.

Joel's army will look like a swarm of locusts to the devil. They have come to devastate his harvest fields. The lost will be saved, the possessed will be freed, the sick will be healed.

Jesus said, to him that believes, all things are possible. He said believers would do the same works He did. Apparently what Jesus calls believing and what we call believing are two different things.

Phase 1 – Present your body a living sacrifice, holy, and acceptable for His use. Every time you obey the voice of your conscience, you are obeying the voice of your King. You do that by obeying the voice of your new nature.

Phase 2 – Renewing the mind. Recoding the brain is part of that process.

Recently, during my times of doing the blueprint, praying and listening I heard Him say;

Believing is recoding the mind. It is a biological, physical disconnecting of old neuropaths and a reconnecting of new neuropaths.

Repetition is a major key exactly the same way that you learned the alphabet and the multiplication tables and everything else that you have learned. The process is precisely the same. This is how you go from unbelief to believing.

How do you go from laughing unbelief to strong in faith like Abraham was in Romans chapter four?

Romans 4:20-21 He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; (21) And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

Hebrews 11:11 Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised.

But they didn't start off that way:

Genesis 17:17 Then Abraham fell upon his face, and laughed, and said in his heart, Shall a child be born unto him that is an hundred years old? and shall Sarah, that is ninety years old, bear?

Genesis 18:12 Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?

Abraham was not a hot rod anymore. Sarah was not ovulating anymore. Impossible by natural means to conceive a baby.

God changed what they said about themselves. By changing their names, He was directing them to say about themselves what God had said about them. Abraham means, I am the father of a multitude. Sarah means, I am the princess who will produce the heir to the throne. (And the lineage of these two would eventually produce the King of Kings ... Jesus Christ the Lord.)

By changing their names, both Abraham and Sarah had to speak the end result. Speaking the end result is the same as ... calling those things which be not as though they were.

Confession is just saying the same thing God says. It is speaking God's Word. What did God say? That's what I say. You say what the Bible says about you. Jesus did that all the time. He was always saying what God said. He was always speaking the Word, and speaking the end result.

Repetition is a major key, just like you learned the alphabet. Abraham and Sarah said it, and said it, and said it ... They went from laughing in unbelief to strong in faith. Then the Holy Spirit said to me;

Rewind all the way back to the Words document that I originally gave you. Upon that foundation is how you rebuild your belief system to align with My belief system.

Those are some things He said to me way back in the eighties that I compiled in what I call the WORDS document. I have been sharing some of those things, and will share more in the future. One of those things is about the water behind the dam.

The water in the lake represents potential energy. Once the water level behind the dam rises above the level of the gates, only then can the gates be opened and the water level flowing through the gates provide the power that generates the electricity. You are the vessel that contains the lake. The water in the lake is the Word. Your tongue is the gate. If you are opening the gate and there is no power flowing, it is because the WORD level is too low.

If we fill ourselves with God's Word, and only say about ourselves what God has said, we will have what we say because we are saying what He said. His Word does not return until Him void, but accomplishes the purpose for which He sent it. He sent His Word and healed us.

Psalms 107:20 He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Isaiah 55:11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.

I was doing one of these videos when the Lord began to speak. The title I put on it was, "My Spoken Word Will Change Your Body." Who has ever heard of such a thing? I know who ... Abraham and Sarah. As they said what God said, their physical bodies changed. Abraham became a hot rod again. After Sarah passed away, Abraham remarried and had six sons by his second wife Keturah. The spoken Word of God changed Abraham's physical body!

By faith, Sarah received strength to conceive seed. She had been barren her whole life. God changed her name to Princess. She said it, she said it, she said it ... her physical body changed to the point it produced an egg again ... a fertile egg that could be impregnated to bring forth the birth of a child.

I say unto you, children, put My Word in your mouth. Bridle your tongue with My Word, says the Lord.

No matter how many failures have been in your past, if you will put My Word in your mouth and speak the end result—if you make a mistake and you speak against it, be quick to repent and I will forgive. And start again—My Word will change you. The same as it changed their bodies [Abraham and Sarah], it will change your bodies.

If you will put My Word in your mouth, what My Son has promised, faith will grow in you and what you say shall come to pass, because you are saying what I say, and My Word does not return unto Me void.

Each and every one of you can go from whatever level you are believing now to being strong in faith. You won't stagger at My Word. You will believe Me, and the world will see My manifestation, says the Lord.

In my own life, there is one area for sure where I have seen this process work. When God called us full time in the ministry, we had no financial support at all. Nobody knew us. Nobody wanted us to come preach for them. Things got very bad financially.

I received instruction from the Lord to pick three verses where He promises to provide for us, and for me to say them out loud four hours a day. I am not making a formula out of that for anybody. All I can do is tell you my own testimony. I started trying to do that and the idea of it seemed so stupid to my natural mind that I would quit after just a few minutes. It made no sense to the natural mind. “How can just speaking words into the air change anything?” (I imagine Abraham and Sarah had similar thoughts when they first started. Remember ... they laughed at first.)

Things got so bad I finally made it the full four hours. The finances did not change that day. I kept doing it ... for days ... for weeks ... and then for about three months. (When God changed Abraham and Sarah's name, it was permanent.)

The finances did not change, but one day I did ... on the inside of me. It's like I had been living in a room of "lack" for a long time, but that day I stepped across a threshold into another room called "provision."

I remember going home, walking in the front door and over to the table where we kept that stack of unpaid bills and I said out loud, "I don't live there anymore." Nothing miraculous happened in our finances that day, but as I look back on it now, that day marked the bottom of our roller coaster ride financially.

Your testimony will be different, but it will start the same way. It begins by putting God's Word in your mouth and saying what He says. Now I understand better why He said that believing involves creating new neural pathways.

Everything that you "know" is comprised of neural pathways that have been created within your physical brain. Those neural pathways get stronger with repetition. Remember when you learned how to drive a car? Your performance was clunky because everything was so new. But with time the car almost becomes a part of you. Everything becomes almost automatic because those neural pathways are now well established.

IS THERE A DIFFERENCE BETWEEN KNOWLEDGE AND APPLIED KNOWLEDGE?

Yes, there is a significant difference between knowledge and applied knowledge:

Knowledge

Definition: Knowledge refers to the understanding or awareness of facts, information, concepts, and principles. It can be theoretical or factual and is often acquired through study, observation, or experience.

Examples: Knowing the theory of relativity, understanding the principles of economics, or being aware of historical events.

Applied Knowledge

Definition: Applied knowledge involves using theoretical knowledge in practical situations. It emphasizes the ability to implement what one knows to solve real-world problems or achieve specific outcomes.

Examples: Using the theory of relativity to calculate GPS satellite positions, applying economic principles to make business decisions, or utilizing historical insights to inform current policy-making.

Key Differences

1. Context: Knowledge is often abstract, while applied knowledge is concrete and context specific.
2. Usage: Knowledge can exist without practical application, but applied knowledge requires the application of that knowledge in real scenarios.
3. Outcome: Applied knowledge typically leads to tangible results or actions, whereas knowledge alone may not.

In summary, while knowledge provides the foundation, applied knowledge translates that foundation into practical skills and solutions.

Examples: My granddaughter learning to drive the car. Me learning how to use my first, used, \$50 computer. When you develop motor skills, you are also accelerating the rate at which new neural pathways are being created in your brain.

WHAT ARE NEURAL PATHWAYS?

Neural pathways are networks of neurons that communicate with each other to transmit signals throughout the nervous system. These pathways are essential for processing information, coordinating responses, and forming the basis of learning and memory.

Key Points:

Structure: Neural pathways consist of interconnected neurons, which transmit electrical impulses and neurotransmitters across synapses.

What we get at our second birth, He received at His first birth. His spirit came from God, but His body came from Mary, and you can trace that all the way back to Adam. The brain of Jesus, the physical gray-matter that made up his brain, was no different than yours. Be encouraged to know that you have the same kind of physical brain that Jesus had.

Jesus was always God in the flesh, but He chose on purpose to set aside all of his privileges and abilities as God so He could live as the example for us. His brain learned to cooperate with His spiritual mind. Later on, we will talk about Jesus walking on the water. Question: Does the natural brain think that a human can walk on water? No, it does not. The natural brain believes in the physics of this world which declares your density as a human is different than the density of water and you cannot walk on it.

The spiritual mind of Jesus received instruction from the Father to walk on the water and it said to the brain, “Come on. We are going to walk on the water.” And the natural brain bowed the knee. We are talking about a really renewed mind here. His brain, like your brain, bowed the knee. That’s a renewed mind. Even though it thinks it is impossible ... even though all of the brain’s natural thinking says “absolutely not” ... His natural brain, a renewed mind, bowed the knee to the spiritual mind and obeyed the instruction of God.

Every time that happens, new neural pathways are created in the natural brain. That’s when the Word of God and your physical brain combine in a way that was never possible before. Let me say it another way: THE WORD BECOMES FLESH. The Word creates physical, neural pathways, that become part of your brain.

Once you have seen a miracle for yourself, once you have experienced a miracle for yourself, there is no going back. You know it is possible now. It’s like the four minute mile. The whole world thought it was impossible for a human to run a mile in under four minutes. Many people tried for decades, and they all failed. Finally, a man broke it. The amazing thing is, once he ran a mile in under four minutes, it started being done by different people all over the world.

There was a stronghold, a natural barrier determined by experience, that existed in the mind of runners all over the world. The stronghold was, “It is impossible for a human to run a mile in under four minutes.” But once one man did it, the limit came off, that stronghold came down and people began doing it all over the world.

Listen close; when it comes to miracles, WE HAVE HAD ONE MAN DO IT! His name is Jesus Christ and He has said, come and follow Me. You will do the same works that I did, and even greater than these will you do, because I go to the Father. And then He seals it up in the next two verses by saying, Whatever you ask in My name, I will do it. Whatever you ask in My name ... I WILL DO IT! Glory to God, His words are spirit and life.

Pre 1960’s, the brain was thought to be much like a machine. That’s because it truly is divided up into parts. Without going into detail, examples would be the frontal cortex has mostly to do with your motor skills, other parts of the brain have to do with speech, other parts have to do with vision, etc. At that time science

thought that if a person had a stroke, which kills a portion of the brain, whatever portion that part of the brain controlled, would be lost forever. They thought the brain was like a machine, and if you break a part off of a machine, the machine does not grow new parts.

Now they know the brain is not exactly like that. The brain is more like plastic than being like a machine made up of metal parts. The technical term is Neuroplasticity.

Neuroplasticity: Neural pathways can change and adapt through experience, a phenomenon known as neuroplasticity. This allows the brain to reorganize itself by forming new connections or strengthening existing ones.

We have machines now that can map the brain. They do scans and can determine which part of the brain is active when you speak, when you watch, when you hear, etc. Now they know that if part of the brain dies, such as during a stroke, you can retrain another part of the brain to take over and do what that portion of the brain did.

They took a totally blind person, born blind and never seen during his whole life, and did some experiments to test this “plasticity” theory. They built something that resembles a dentist chair, and they built a sensor pad that would go on the person’s back. When you sat in the chair your back would be against the sensor pad. The sensor pad was connected to a black and white television camera. It was designed so that when the television camera detected lighter images, certain electric impulses were sent to the back pad. When darker symbols were detected by the camera, it would send different electronic impulses to the back pad.

This experiment sends electric impulses to a transmitter in a pad on the person’s back based on the lightness or darkness of the images detected by the camera. The person receiving the signals is totally blind, having never seen anything in his life. These impulses are being transmitted “through his back” and then passing on to the brain via the person’s nervous system.

With some training through experience, the blind person came to the place where he could say things like, “Oh, I see that Mary is in the room today. She has her hand on the back of her head. She is wearing her hair up today. She has her glasses on.” My first thought when I read about this was, the man is seeing with his back.

But not really. None of us actually see with our eyes. We receive visual input signals with our eyes, which then transmits data to our brain through the nervous system. It is the brain that literally translates those electric impulses into what we call vision. We don't see with our eyes. We see with our brains.

In this experiment, the man is receiving the electric impulses through sensors on his back instead of his eyes. Those electric impulses are being transmitted to the brain via his nervous system. The brain then sorts those electronic impulses into images. He is receiving data through his back, but he is seeing with his brain ... just like we all do.

Everything that goes to your brain is electrical. Example: When I look at an image with my eyes, what travels through the optic nerve up the brain is not an image, like a printed picture or something. The eye is the receptor. It receives data; light, dark, color, shade, texture, etc. It then sends that information electronically up the optic nerve to the brain. It is the brain that organizes all of those electronic impulses into images. You literally see with your brain.

Without the eye, there is no receptor to send those electronic signals to the brain (unless you have a back pad transmitter hooked to a camera).

This is important. All of the five senses work that way. Touch, smell, audio. Our sensory input comes through our fingers, our eyes, ears, nose, etc. As far as your brain is concerned, all of those various means of data input come in the form of electronic signals. They fire these neurons across synapses in the brain. Patterns are formed. If they are the wrong patterns, but you believe it, that becomes a stronghold in the brain. A stronghold is a neural pathway that's going to have to be dismantled.

God's truth is normally "brand new material" for the natural brain. The natural brain is of this world, and it believes, "This is possible and that is not possible." But the spiritual mind knows all things are possible to him that believes.

Preview: Praying in tongues is a major tool the Holy Spirit uses to teach your spiritual mind what is really possible in the kingdom of God. The natural brain has to be retrained to become a renewed mind that not only has knowledge, but bows

the knee to the superior knowledge of your spiritual mind. We have the mind of Christ. Truly, all things are possible.

Start training yourself now. Stop calling those things that are the way they are. Start speaking the end result. Say about yourself what God says about you. The first thing He says is ... He loves you.
