

The Victor

Be not anxious nor moved by anything that you see or perceive by the senses, says the Lord. Be only moved by those things that I reveal to you by My Spirit. Be very calm. Be at peace, knowing that you are the victor. Knowing that I have sent you in already as the conqueror, for I am with you says the Lord.

Fear not. Fear not. Be not moved. Be at peace. Rest in the place of the victor, for that is who I am in you and that is what I have made you ... the victor! You always triumph through Me. You always triumph. You are the one in authority. You are the one in control. Be not moved.

My voice. My voice. Hearken to My voice only and do not leap into the chambers of the soul for counsel, but rather rely upon My voice. Rely upon My voice as I speak to you in your spirit.

DON'T WORRY. BE AT PEACE

Php 4:6-7 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. KJV

Php 4:6 Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything, by prayer and petition (definite requests), with thanksgiving, continue to make your wants known to God. AMPLIFIED

DON'T EVER LET THE DEVIL PUT YOU ON YOUR KNEES. (Do you ever remember once where a bad report sent Jesus to His knees in prayer?) No, He knew who His Father was and He knew He was in authority. Remember the instruction regarding "alarms of the soul."

2Co 4:18 While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.

Joh 5:30 I am able to do nothing from Myself [independently, of My own accord--but only as I am taught by God and as I get His orders]. Even as I hear, I judge [I decide as I am bidden to decide. As the voice comes to Me, so I give a decision], and My judgment is right (just, righteous), because I do not seek or consult My own will [I have no desire to do what is pleasing to Myself, My own aim, My own purpose] but only the will and pleasure of the Father Who sent Me.

"I HAVE SENT YOU IN." That mindset is so important for us to have. Christians seem to always have a "defensive posture" fighting off the onslaughts of the enemy. But God sees us as the invading army, sent forth to rescue as many of the sons and daughters of Adam as possible, and to set all the captives free who have been oppressed by the devil. God is with us. He does not send us in to war in our own strength. HE IS WITH US.

THE FATHER REVEALED TO JESUS BY THE HOLY SPIRIT:

- 1. This sickness is not unto death.**
- 2. Lazarus has died.**

3. It is safe now to go back to Bethany.

YOU ARE THE VICTOR ... BECAUSE:

1Jn 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

- 1. When they stoned Paul and left him for dead, Paul was the victor.**
- 2. When they placed Paul and Silas in the stocks in prison, they were the victors.**
- 3. When Paul was bitten by a poisonous snake, Paul was the victor.**

2Co 2:14 Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

With a kingdom mentality, we win if we are successful in making manifest the savour of His knowledge in every place. It does not matter regarding our person or our possessions. God will restore whatever we need to keep putting first the Kingdom of God. That is the true meaning of:

Luk 6:35-38 But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and to the evil. 36 Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful. 37 Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven: 38 Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.
